An Overview of Residential Services

Over the past year, we followed the completion of Orchard Court Apartments, the Counseling Center's 15 unit independent apartment complex for young adults with a serious psychiatric illness. In addition, the Center has five other residential sites, all in Wooster. Residential services provide group home support and treatment options. There are a total of five residential homes in the Wooster area; three residential treatment sites and two residential support sites. In total our group homes can accommodate up to 30 clients. Clients referred to the program must be Wayne county residents and must follow the following housing referral priorities:

- ★ Severely mentally ill in need of and qualifies for case management services.
- → Currently hospitalized with no placement available.
- ✦ Homeless.
- **→** Recent psychiatric hospitalization.
- ✦ History of multiple hospitalizations.
- → Clinical need for support and supervision.

sion, room, board, medication and symptom monitoring, skill development, social and recreational activities and mental health treatment. The home is furnished and includes telephone, cable, cleaning supplies, laundry and transportation. We have one home for women and two homes for men one of which serves men with developmental disabilities and mental illness.

Our residential **support** sites offer the some of the same amenities (room, medication and symptom monitoring, skill development, social and recreational activities and mental health treatment), but staff are available fewer hours; 11 hours per day and 8 hours on weekends. The Support homes include a partially supervised home for 5 women with mental illnesses (plus 1 respite bed used for emergency short term stay situations) and a partially supervised home for 5 men with mental illnesses.
