
## ORCHARD COURT APARTMENTS: AN ENTERPRISE GREEN COMMUNITY

To achieve this designation, the building project had to meet strict standards and over 100 specific criteria focusing on transforming the quality of affordable housing. This is part of a national effort to ensure that those living in affordable housing have the opportunity to be healthier, spend less on utilities, and have more opportunities to connect to transportation, quality food and healthcare systems.
