SUICIDE PREVENTION

For youth between the ages of 10 and 24 suicide is the third leading cause of death. It is also a preventable cause. During the recently completed fiscal year, the Counseling Center provided depression awareness and suicide prevention services to nearly 1,000 students in local high schools and middle schools. At the conclusion of the program and with parental permission, 399 students completed a specific depression screening and of this group 21 reported having thoughts of suicide in the last month and 18 reported at least one prior suicide attempt. We appreciate our partnership with local educational organizations which makes this necessary program possible.
