THE COUNSELING CENTER HOSTS ORRVILLE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

CONTINUING EDUCATION PROVIDER

The Counseling Center has received renewal of our continuing education provider status from the Ohio Counselor, Social Worker and Marriage and Family Therapy Board for Counselor and Social Worker programs. In the previous two years the Center provided 111.00 CEU hours to our clinical staff and the community at special events.

NEW STAFF

TRAUMA-FOCUSED TRAINING

Several counseling staff recently attended a two-day training on trauma-focused cognitive behavioral therapy. The training was held at Akron Children's Hospital, and was provided by a grant the hospital received from the National Child Traumatic Stress Network. The extensive training will continue over the next year, and will include monthly case consultations as well as additional training at the hospital. It will lead to certification in trauma-focused therapy.



While the training concentrates on treating children and adolescents, the techniques are also applicable to adults.
