## **NEW ORRVILLE LOCATION**

The Counseling Center's Orrville office will be moving to a new location on October 1, 2014. The new offices are located at 859 S. Main, directly across from Aultman Dunlap hospital, in a building that was formerly occupied by Dr. Michael Guster and his optometry practice. "The Center's current location on Crown Hill Road has been our home for many years," noted President/CEO Susan Buchwalter, "and we have made good use of that space. However, our new location, in addition to being more convenient for the community, offers us more windows, a handicapped accessible bathroom, a better reception space, and a larger room which can be used for meetings or groups." During the month of September the facility is being remodeled, painted and having new carpet installed. "We think it will be a great facility for our Orrville patients and for the community," noted Buchwalter.

According to the Counseling Center's annual report, 185 different patients were served at the Center's Orrville location in fiscal year 2014. The office is staffed with a part time psychologist, a part-time counselor and a receptionist. The office is open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Mondays and from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Thursdays. "If this new location results in increased demand for services in eastern Wayne County, we now have the flexibility and the space to respond by assigning extra staff," noted Buchwalter, "We look forward to a strong and long term relationship with the community." The Orrville location is partially supported by the Orrville Area United Way. According to Buchwalter, "United Way has assisted us in maintaining an Orrville location for over 30 years; and their support was a key factor in our decision to make this move," noted Buchwalter.
