

WRAP AROUND SERVICES

Your family may benefit from WrapAround Services if you and/or your child are experiencing a combination of the following :

- Difficulty in school
- Behavioral issues
- Aggressive or violent behaviors
- Difficulty following the rules
- Court involvement and/or court diversion
- Involvement with Child Protective Services
- Mental Health issues
- Drug and/or alcohol involvement
- Difficulty in coordinating multiple services

What can the family expect?

The Service Coordinator introduces the WrapAround process to the family, helps identify the service providers and other people that provide natural supports to the youth and family. The process includes:

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| Step I: | Family Sharing |
| Step II: | Discovering Family Strengths, Needs, Culture |
| Step III: | Developing a Plan |
| Step IV: | Working the Plan |
| Step V: | Moving Forward |

What is WrapAround:

WrapAround is a process where the strengths, culture and challenges of a youth and their family are identified and a plan is developed that provides both formal and informal supports to assist the youth and their family to have safety, stability, and success.



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
